(Image: Glenn van der Heyden/Corbis) This month marks the 200th anniversary of Mary MacKillop's death and our celebration has been marked by a number of major initiatives and celebrations. The idea for the national observance of her death was developed in the early years of the twentieth century by the Congregation of the Sisters of St Joseph in Sydney. These Sisters, who wanted to see women recognised as having an important place in Australian religious life, began observing the anniversary of her death every year. At the first national meeting of the Sisters of St Joseph in 1908, it was agreed that the first observance of her death would be held in Sydney. Mary's contribution to the leadership of Australian Catholics has been recognised in a number of ways. In December 2008, the Sisters of St Joseph named a college for girls in their congregation after her. There has been a significant increase in the number of priests, Sisters and lay people in Australia who were inspired by her ministry and by the example of the parish priest at St Joseph's. Advertisement In the 1970s the Australian government established the Australian Catholic University to recognise the contribution of outstanding Catholic leaders to the welfare of Australians. The vice-chancellor of ACU, Monsignor Denis McGrath, said of Mary's influence on the university, 'The postgraduate students of the 1970s could only have known Mary MacKillop as an inspirational leader who changed the Catholic Church in Australia for ever and for the better.' At the beginning of the 1980s, a special Mass was held for all who had come to know Mary in her lifetime. That Mass celebrated the canonisation of the 82157476af
